

TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS TO CAMP FOR SECOND SESSION
Wednesday, July 9, 2008

CHICAGO AREA:

The bus will be leaving at 8:00 AM (CT), Wednesday, July 9, from the Old Navy parking lot in Skokie Point; 9435 Skokie Blvd., Skokie, IL 60077. (Near Golf Road and Skokie Blvd.) Danny Kanter will be the contact person and he can be reached at 847-254-8224.

DETROIT/ANN ARBOR AREA:

The bus will leave the Oak Park JCC at 9:00 AM on Wednesday, July 9. The contact person in Detroit will be Olga Friedman and she can be reached at 248-535-1088. The bus will proceed directly to the Ann Arbor JCC and should arrive at 9:45 AM and will depart Ann Arbor at 10:00 AM. Ron Sussman will be meeting the bus in Ann Arbor and can be reached at 313-702-3116. If there are any problems with the above numbers, please call the camp.

REMINDERS:

Madrichim (counselors) will be at each site. They will supervise loading and collect medications and kupah money if not paid already. (For new parents, please see the section on kupah in the handbook.) Fifty dollars per child is the suggested amount. ****Please be sure your camper's health form 1, health form 2, insurance card copy (front and back) and consent form is mailed to the **camp address** by 7/2 (59884 Arthur L. Jones Road, Three Rivers, MI 49093).*

PARENTS WHO ARE BRINGING THEIR CHILDREN:

Please remember the possible time change when you are planning your arrival at camp. The busses are scheduled to arrive at camp about 12:30 PM EDT (Michigan time). **From Detroit/Ann Arbor: Summer 2008 – The ramp connecting I-94 and 131 is closed. Please follow these alternative directions.** Take I-94 west to exit 76A (Westnedge Avenue, South). Continue south on Westnedge Avenue, which eventually turns into Shaver Road. Shaver Road ends at 131. Turn left (south) onto 131. Follow 131 to Three Rivers. Turn right on Broadway (at Meijer) and go about 4 miles to A. L. Jones Rd. (just past the "Boot Lake Ranch" archway on the right). Turn left onto A. L. Jones Rd. and look for the entrance to camp on the right after passing Norton School. Please try to schedule your arrival no earlier than this time. The madrichim have a lot to do and really need the whole morning to get ready for the kids. If you must be a lot earlier or later, please call.
